ROYCE ZACKERY is a native of Atlanta, Georgia. He is certified in teaching the American Ballet Teaching Curriculum, received his B.F.A. from Southern Methodist University and a Masters in Higher Education from NYU. Mr. Zackery has danced professionally for over 15 years with various companies and teaching professionally for 12 years. Royce has taught master classes, workshops and choreographed in classical/contemporary ballet, lyrical movement, tap and classical/contemporary partnering in numerous cities in the US, such as Texas, Oklahoma, Georgia, NY, and abroad, such as Germany and Russia to name a few. He has been on staff at Broadway Dance Center, the Alvin Ailey Extension Program and the School at Steps on Broadway. This is Royce's first year teaching at CBTB Dance Academy, and second season dancing with Covenant Ballet Theatre.
